Philip H. Ralstin, 89 of Rushville, passed away on August 18, 2017 at his home. He was born on October 5, 1927 in Rush County to the late Everett C. and Lavina (Hanshew) Ralstin. Philip married Nora (Hornaday) Ralstin on June 30, 1945 and she survives. He worked 8 years for the B&O railroad then for Indiana Gas Company and Vectren for over 36 years retiring in 1990. Philip was a member of the First Presbyterian Church and a prior member of First Baptist Church. He was an Elder for the First Presbyterian Church and past president of the Eagles. Philip was a 5 time Past Master for the Andersonville F&AM #96 over 50 years. He was a member of the Scottish Rite and also was very active coach of Club League, Little League and Babe Ruth League. 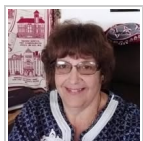
