Reno J. Gosser, 92 of Rushville, passed away March 10, 2026 in Rushville. He was born October 27, 1933 in Pulaski County, KY to the late William and Lula Mae (Wilson) Gosser. Reno was a Mays High School graduate. He served his country in the United States Army for 2 years.

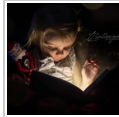

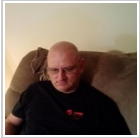
