James Reece, 94 of Greensburg, passed away January 6, 2025 in Greensburg. He was born October 17, 1930 in Commiskey, IN to the late Eldon O. and Britomarte (James) Reece. James graduated from Vernon High School in 1950. He served in the United States Airforce from 1950-1954. After college he married Susie Gabbard on June 27, 1959 and she survives. James taught Elementary school for over 26 years. Throughout his career he pastored several small churches in Central Indiana as a Southern Baptist eventually working for Southern Baptist Association from 1990-1998. James served the Lord with great compassion and enthusiasm. He was a member of First Southern Baptist Church for over 20 years in Rushville.
