Rev. James Ward, born August 16, 1938, in Washington, PA, passed from this life to his eternal reward, Thursday evening, February 17, 2022 at his home.

He was a quiet and steady man who gave his life to ministry, teaching, his family and his walk with the Lord. He pastored churches in Pennsylvania and Indiana, most recently at Clarksburg Covenant Church. He taught at Covenant Foundation College, God's Bible School and College and Union Bible College.
