Robert M. Miller, 88, of Rushville, passed away August 13, 2017 in Rushville. He was born June 29, 1929 in Knightstown to Charles & Anna (Hummel) Miller. Robert served in the USAF. He married Marian Frederick on October 30, 1949.

Bob lived his entire life in Carthage and Rushville. He served 23 years on the Rushville Police Department, retiring in 1978. He was Chief of Police for nearly 11 years.

Bob was a long time member & past deacon at the Main Street Christian Church. He was a member of the Rushville Masonic Lodge #62 F&AM, the Scottish Rite and Murat Shrine, Rushville Elks Lodge, American Legion, Past President of the Rushville Coin Club, the Rushville Saddle Club and the FOP and was a Charter member of the Rushville Roadrunners.

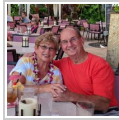
