Robert C. "Bob" Jordan, 84, a lifelong Rushville resident passed away Wednesday, April 13, 2016 in Indianapolis, IN. Bob was born in Rushville, IN on May 26, 1931 to the late Chester "Chet" and Mae Ruth (Casey) Jordan. Bob was a 1948 graduate of Rushville High School. Bob served in the U.S. Air Force from 1950 to 1953. He worked at Meijers in Noblesville for 20 years. Bob was a member of the Rushville American Legion Post #150 and the Shriners. He was an avid Detroit Tigers fan, loved baseball and was an active bowler in Rushville.
