



## Roger (Ramjet) Rosfeld

October 1, 1958 - April 29, 2026

Roger (Ramjet) Rosfeld, 67, of Rushville, passed away April 29, 2026 at his home. Roger was born October 1, 1958 in Rushville to Paul F. & Dorine A. (Hoeing) Rosfeld. He was a 1976 graduate of Rushville Consolidated High School.

Roger worked at Curtis Brother's in Rushville after graduation. He moved to Florida for a brief time and then returned home to begin his career as an electrician. He worked for Marsh and Edwards Electric before his 29 year career with Rosfeld Electric where he retired in 2023.

Roger was a longtime member of St. Mary's Catholic Church in Rushville, the Pioneer Engineer's Club of Rush County, Rushville Elks Lodge #1307 and the Rushville Knights of Columbus #769. He was a Grand Knight 2 times and received Star Council. Roger was also instrumental in orchestrating Race Knights through the K of C.

He is survived by his wife; Deborah A. Rosfeld of Rushville, daughters; Krista (Matt) Richey and Kyla (Alex) Shaver all of Rushville, brothers; John P. 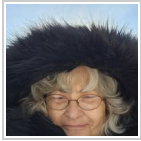
