Steven “Steve” Johnson, 62 of Milroy, passed away on February 6, 2023 in Indianapolis. He was born on November 29, 1960 in Rushville, IN to the late Thomas R. and Marcella (Lewark) Johnson. Steve was a 1979 graduate of Rushville High School. He married Pam Simmons Johnson on August 8, 1981 and she survives. Steve has been a lifelong farmer in Rush County. He was a bus driver for Rush County Schools since 1989, driving the varsity teams to their away games. Steve also was a book keeper for all sports through Rushville High School. 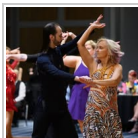

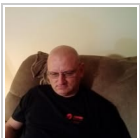

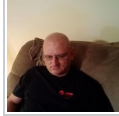
