Sue W. Moster, 81, a long time Rushville resident, passed away Sunday, March 1, 2015 at her home with her family surrounding her. She was born July 19, 1933 in Augusta, KY to John F. & Mary Helen (Boothe) Wuthrich. She spent two years in Augusta until her family moved to Muncie in 1935. Sue was a 1951 graduate of Muncie Burriss High School, received her BS in 1955 from Ball State University and her MA in 1958 in Speech Pathology from Ball State University. Sue married US Navy Lt. JG Michael Curts in December of 1955 and he passed away in May 1957. She married Richard F. Moster on August 9, 1958 and he survives.

Sue had lived in Rushville since 1958. She and Dick had summered in Carp Lake, MI since 1990. Sue was a speech & hearing therapist with the Rush County School Systems for 15 years. She was a long time member of St. Paul United Methodist Church, Associate Chapter of Tri Kappa, Pi Beta Phi Sorority at Ball State University, Girl Scout Leader 1972-1976, PEO Chapter M-Rushville, coached Little Girls Softball and was active in both the Rush County & Indiana State Retired Teachers Association.

Sue will always be remembered for her love of family, friends, travel, bridge games, double sol, bird watching, enjoying a good book and her common kindness to all.

She is survived by her husband, Richard F. of Rushville, a son, Daniel F. & wife Susan Moster of Ft. Wayne, daughters, Amy J. (Karen) Moster of Columbus, IN, Ann C. (Benda) Moster of Glenwood and Ellen E. Moster of

Petosky, MI, a brother, retired Lt. Col USMC John R. & wife Claudia Wuthrich of Muncie, grandchildren, Eric & Drew Scher, Katelyn & Anna Moster, Bradley (Amy) Cain & Dustin Cain and great grandchildren, Quentin Gallagher & Elise Sue Ann Cain. Sue was also survived by special nieces, Kim (Kevin) Abney and Kelly (Steve) Maines and nephews, John (Julie) Wuthrich and Steve (Ann) Wuthrich.
