Taylor was born on November 16, 1992 in Greenfield, Indiana to Beth Williams May. Taylor lived most of her life in Noblesville, IN living with her mother. As she got older, Taylor moved into a group home at Damar Services and then, after living with her mother in Rushville, she moved to a residential home in Connersville, Indiana with services provided by Benchmark.

Taylor enjoyed watching Barney, swimming, swinging, playing with plastic bags, listening to music and eating cheeseburgers from McDonald's. She was a very special girl who loved being with her family and spreading joy and love to all who became part of her life.

Her family knew her as Tay-Tay, Bug and little Lu-La-Lu. She was diagnosed with cerebral palsy after beginning to have seizures at 3 ½ months of age at Vanderbilt Hospital in Nashville, TN. As a young baby the doctors said she would never walk, but Taylor overcame that obstacle. People in her life recognized that, although she could not talk, she understood a lot and would definitely make her wants / needs known. She had a contagious giggle and a smile that would light up the world. Her spirit was pure and she touched many people's hearts and lives.

Taylor is survived by her mother, Beth Williams May, her siblings Madison May, Aaron May, Emily May and Ethan May, her Nana, Diana Cole, her four aunts, her five uncles, her nineteen cousins, and many second cousins. She is preceded in death by her younger brother, Jacob Michael May, her

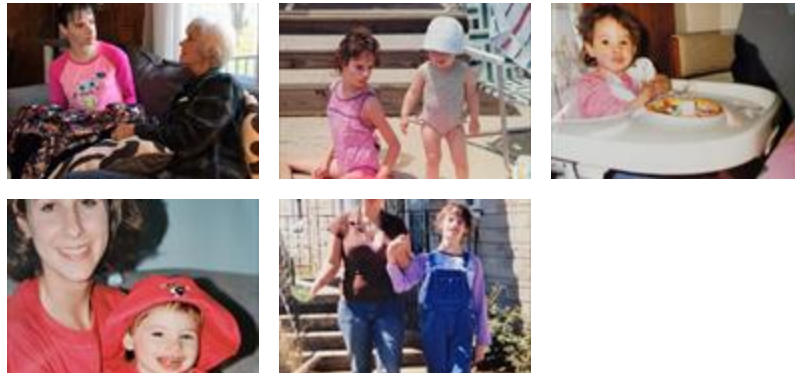
