



## Weldon Russell Carfield

November 19, 1928 - March 18, 2017

Weldon Russell Carfield, 88, a lifelong Rush County resident passed away Saturday, March 18, 2017 at his home. Weldon was born in Rushville on November 19, 1928 to the late Russell and Esther (Junkin) Carfield. He was a 1946 graduate of Rushville High School and attended Purdue University studying agriculture.

Weldon married Doris E. Towne on November 24, 1957 and she preceded him in death on December 29, 2006. Weldon was a Rush County farmer. Weldon served during the Korean War in the U.S. Army at Camp Gordon in Augusta Georgia. He was a member of the Rushville Consolidated High School Board from 1972- 1980 and was also a member of Hannegan Christian Church the Rushville Masonic Lodge, Scottish Rite, Murat Shrine and the Rush County Farm Bureau. Weldon loved animals and farming.

Survivors include 2 sons, Keith Carfield and wife Angie of Rushville, Kent Carfield and wife Lisa of Rush County and 5 grandchildren, Brock, Kailey, Dustin, Andrew and Sarah Carfield.

In addition to his parents and wife, Weldon was preceded in death by his brother Richard Carfield.

Graveside services will be held at 1 PM Tuesday, March 21, 2017 at Arlington East Hill Cemetery. Tony Augsburger will preside.
