William N. Moore, 81, a life long Rush County resident, passed away December 29, 2013 at his home in Rushville. Bill was born November 13, 1932 in Arlington, IN to Willdean & Wilna (Tribby) Moore. He was a 1950 graduate of Arlington High School and was a US Air Force veteran, serving from 1950-1953. He married Muriel Peabody on November 21, 1953.

Bill worked in Indianapolis for Indiana Insurance Company for nearly 40 years, retiring in 1993. After retiring, Bill worked at Tweedy Lumber Company in Rushville for many years. He was a member of St. Paul's United Methodist Church where he had served as trustee for the church and the United Methodist District Office.
